Minutes of the Thursday, February 25, 2022 Regular Meeting

Call to Order and Roll Call

Approval of Meeting Agenda

Action Items

Chair Kvedaras requested a motion to recommend to the full Board the waiving of the initial reading of, and publish proposed regulation regarding, revolving door prohibition of the Illinois State Officials and Employees Act as presented in the Committee Book. Trustee Harrell motioned. Trustee Kvedaras seconded. Kaitlyn Wild presented the motion. A discussion ensued. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Chair Kvedaras requested a motion to recommend to the full Board the waiving of the initial readings of, and publish proposed regulations regarding, drug-free workplace and revolving pre-employment background checks, as presented in the Committee Book. Trustee Harrell motioned. Trustee Kvedaras seconded. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Executive Session

Trustee Harrell motioned that the Committee go into Executive Session at 9:11 a.m., pursuant to Section 2(c)(1) of the Illinois Open Meetings Act, to discuss personnel matters. Chair Kvedaras seconded. Roll call was taken and Trustees Harrell and Kvedaras voted to pass the motion.

The Committee returned to open session at 10:06 a.m. Chair Kvedaras noted that no action was taken in executive session.

Chair Kvedaras requested a motion to recommend to the full Board the approval of a contract in excess of \$100,000 to the law firm of Barnes & Thornburg regarding investigation of employment complaints, as presented in the Committee Book. Trustee Harrell motioned. Trustee Kvedaras seconded. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

There being no old business and no new business, the meeting adjourned at 10:09 a.m. with a motion from Trustee Harrell and a second from Trustee Kvedaras. The motion passed unanimously.
