Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GovState) for the Criminal Justice degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from JJC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Criminal Justice at GovState.

Selectives (15 hours)

Students must also take 15 credits of selective courses from approved list in GSU catalog. Students also have the option to complete a concentration in Restorative Justice. Three hours were completed through the JJC courses above.

Electives (17 Hours)*

A minimum of 1 hour has to be at the 3000-4000 level.

Minimum Required for BA in Criminal Justice: 120 Hours *Up to 16 hours could be completed at JJC.
