# Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration

This is based on the 2023-2024 Academic Year and is based on successful completion of 12 hours a semester with Summers. Students must choose the Business Focus Area. Refer to the document “General Education Requirements for General Studies Students – First Year Students” for details on the required general education courses for each cohort. For all general education courses, you must earn a “C” or better. Students with Advanced Placement or other approved transfer and early college coursework need to contact their advisor right away so that you don’t duplicate credits.
