Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education

This is based on the 2023-2024 Academic Year and is based on successful completion of course work to be completed in summers. Students must choose the Education Focus Area. Students must earn a grade of “C” or better for all courses and a gpa of 2.75 for gen ed courses; and a “B” or better for all professional EDUC, EMED, EDCP, and SPED courses. Students with Advanced Placement or other approved transfer and early college coursework need to contact their advisor right away so that you don’t duplicate credits.
