

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Criminal Justice degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Criminal Justice from GSU.
