Bachelor of Science in Nursing

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Moraine Valley Community College (MVCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Community Health degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Nursing from MVCC and a Bachelors of Science (BSN) degree in Nursing from GSU. Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for admission to the program. The BSN degree is offered at GSU completely online.

^GSU CHEM 1143/1144 Chemistry II or CHEM 1113/1114 Intro-Organic & Bio Chemistry with Lab can be completed in place of MVCC CHM 132. CHEM 1113/1114 is an applied nursing focused Organic Chemistry.

NOTE: All transfer course work must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.
