

Associate of Applied Science in Nursing to Bachelor of Science in Nursing

This is an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Nursing degree based upon the current catalogs of both schools. Students would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degree in Nursing from PSC and a Bachelor of Science (BSN) Degree in Nursing from GSU. **Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for admission to the program. The BSN degree is offered at GSU completely online.**

**30 semester credit hours of lower division Nursing courses will be accepted for transfer towards the BSN; however 41 semester credit hours are required for the AAS in Nursing. No course work will need to be repeated at GSU.

[^]GSU CHEM 1143/1144 Chemistry II or CHEM 1113/1114 Intro-Organic & Bio Chemistry with Lab can be completed in place of PSC CHEM 130. CHEM 1113/1114 is an applied nursing focused Organic Chemistry.

NOTE: All transfer course work must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.
