

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology and Sociology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Anthropology and Sociology degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Art (AA) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Anthropology and Sociology from GSU.

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE (37-38 Hours)

(Meets SOC 1100 **or** SOC 2100)

II. ELECTIVES (24-25 Hours)

GSU's Anthropology and Sociology program suggests classes in any of the social sciences.

- SOCIO 220 - Race Relations: A Multicultural Perspective (recommended)
(Meets ANSO 2200 for Sociology concentration)
- SOCIO 210 - Marriage and the Family (recommended)
- SOCIO 215 - Sex, Gender and Power (recommended)
(Meets ANSO2100 for Sociology concentration)

Electives (31-34 Hours)

Additional courses as approved by academic advisor. Language study is highly recommended for students concentrating in Anthropology seeking graduate level anthropology training. An additional sociological theories course and an advanced statistics course is highly recommended for students concentrating in Sociology seeking graduate level sociology training.
