

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art (Film Arts Option)

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Art degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from KCC and a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) degree in Art from GSU. All students are admitted conditionally. The art faculty will monitor and evaluate student progress continuously. All art students will have a mandatory portfolio evaluation after 1 year of enrollment.
