

Governors State University Summer STEAM Camp 2019

Need-Based Scholarship Guidelines

A limited number of need-based partial scholarships for Governors State University's Summer 2019 STEAM Camp will be awarded, subject to funds availability. Parents/ guardians and prospective campers may apply for scholarships for one or both weeks.

Parents or guardians are responsible for the remaining \$25 per camper, per session camp fee (\$50 if attending both sessions), transportation to/ from camp, meals, snacks incidentals, and any expenses related to the optional Steam Camp Plus after-camp program.

Scholarship Guidelines

Parent/ guardian's gross household income (i.e. before taxes are withheld) must fall at or below the U.S. Poverty Income Guidelines per below. Additionally, prospective students must include a brief, substantive 250 word essay describing what they hope to learn from their participation in the program.
