

The Dual Degree Program (DDP) Honors Scholarship is a competitive, merit-based scholarship. This scholarship is open to students who are enrolled in the GSU Dual Degree Program, are active members of their community college Honors Program or chapter of Phi Theta Kappa Honors Society, have a 3.5 or above GPA, and meet the criteria below. Scholarship awards cover the full cost of tuition and fees at GSU for a maximum of four (4) semesters (excluding summers).

Application Deadlines

The deadlines to submit an application with required documents are listed below. New scholarships will not be awarded for the Summer session.

Fall 2018	Spring 2019
February 16, 2018	October 5, 2018

Criteria

- Participation in the GSU Dual Degree Program
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 on a 4 point scale at time of application and time of transfer
- Participation in current community college Honors Program or Phi Theta Kappa Honors Society membership
- Plan to enroll full-time at GSU in the fall or spring semester immediately following completion of Associate degree
- First time transfer students only (Must be full time at community college at time of application)

Application Procedures

- 1. Complete an application for admission to GSU (recommend completion 2 to 3 weeks in advance of scholarship deadline in order to receive GSU student ID number).
- 2. Complete the DDP Honors Scholarship application.
- 3. Submit a personal statement that is no more than three (3) double spaced, type-written pages describing the following:
- a. Your academic/professional experience and goals and how receiving this scholarship will help you achieve those goals; b. Your community service, extracurricular activities, and leadership skills and experience.
- 4. Submit two (2) completed and signed DDP Honors Scholarship Recommendation Forms from a community college advisor counselor, a faculty member, staff member, or administrator who are knowledgeable about your academic potential and professional character.
- 5. Complete the FAFSA application online before November 1 for determination of Pell Grant eligibility. *(Pell grant eligibility is not required, but completion of the FAFSA is still required.)*
- 6. Submit official transcripts from all colleges or universities you have attended.
- 7. The application and all required documents must be received by the deadline.

Scholarship Recipient Responsibilities

- Maintain a semester and cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 on a 4 point scale to maintain scholarship eligibility.
- Be enrolled full-time -- a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours -- each semester at GSU.
- Enroll and participate in the GSU Honors Program and assist with DDP activities as needed.
- Every semester, submit a statement to the committee that describes your active participation in the GSU community (i.e. student clubs, programs, committees, community service, etc.) and/or your local community (ongoing volunteerism, service projects, etc.). Also include your enrollment plans for the next semester. This is due on December 1 for Fall semester and May 1 for Spring semester.
- The scholarship covers the cost of tuition and fees for up to four (4) semesters (not including summers). The scholarship ends when the recipient completes his or her bachelor's degree.
- Failure to meet any of the above obligations may result in termination of the recipient's scholarship eligibility.
