Passwords


You will be prompted to change your password the first time you log into the MyGSU Portal and again every 120 days. Be sure to choose a password that is easy to remember but hard for others to guess. In order to ensure full password security, please take these additional steps to protect your password:

- Don't share your password. You're responsible for all activities conducted on your account.
- Make sure you log off MyGSU when using a public computer. You must also close the browser for the log-off process to be complete. If you don't properly log off, someone else may be able to access your information.
- Don't store your password in a program. When your email client or web browser stores your passwords, it is very easy for a hacker or computer virus to retrieve them without your knowledge.
