### **GRADUATES MUST ASSEMBLE WITH THEIR RESPECTIVE COLLEGES**

- Eligibility: graduates from fall 2014, and applicants for graduation for spring and summer of 2015.
- Tickets: Participants will receive seven (7) four (4) tickets for the ceremony and two (2) parking passes. At this time, extra tickets are NOT available. Ticket pick-up will take place on May 5 from 8 am to 2 pm and May 6 from 11 am to 7:30 pm in the Cafeteria Annex. A photo ID will be required. Check the Commencement website for more information.
  - o All guests must have tickets to be seated (including children 2 years and older)
  - o Infants and toddlers may be seated in the lap
  - Children may not sit with graduates
  - o A family friendly seating area will be available to guests with children

- Parking is limited
  - o Carpooling is strongly encouraged
  - Observe all parking signs to avoid being ticketed or towed
  - o Parking lots fill up quickly.
  - Display parking pass in car window

  - o Central Middle School, 18146 Oak Park Avenue, Tinley Park
  - Shuttle Buses will be available for transport to and from the convention center near NORTH ENTRANCE.

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# **Commencement Day Reminders**

### For Graduates

- Plan to arrive early
- o Inform guests of the college/program you are graduating from to assist with seating (i.e. College of Health and Human Services; Nursing)
- o Pre-arrange a meeting location to meet family and guests after the ceremony outside of the auditorium.
- Please leave personal items (such as purses) with your guests or leave locked in your vehicle. Neither
   GSU nor the convention center is responsible for lost or stolen items.
- o Only GSU approved honors cords and stoles may be worn with regalia.
- Graduates should not leave the ceremony floor until the appropriate time. Only Platform Guests,
   Faculty/Staff, and Marshals will recess out. <u>All graduates are to remain seated throughout the ceremony</u> unless directed otherwise by the commencement marshals or master of ceremonies.

#### For Guests

- o Doors open at 8:30 a.m. or 3:30 p.m. respectively
  - Saving seats is not permitted
  - Seats are not guaranteed for late arrivals
  - Admission will be temporarily suspended <u>at 9:50 a.m.</u> and <u>4:50 p.m.</u> respectively in preparation for the procession of graduates.
  - Remain in seats for the entire commencement ceremony
- o A family friendly seating area will be available to guests with children
- Grad Flowers will be making variety of fresh cut flowers available for guests to purchase between the
   West and South Entrances
  - All flowers will be offered in a variety of colors as half dozen or full dozen
  - They will also be hand wrapped on location with baby's breath and greens with a choice of custom school colored bow.
  - Flowers are to be given to graduates AFTER the ceremony is complete.
- No balloons or large gifts are allowed in the convention center.
- No photographs or videotaping in the front, side or middle aisles.
  - A live webcast will be available through GSU's website on commencement day

- o The Follett Bookstore will offer a 10% discount to all graduates and guests at the convention center.

### For everyone:
