



## **Transfer Guide for Associate of Arts Accounting**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Accounting degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from one of the CCC and a Bachelors of Science (BS) degree in Accounting from GSU.
