



**Transfer Guide for Associate of Arts
Art**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between the City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the English degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from one of the CCC and a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) degree in Art from GSU. **The BFA in Art requires a portfolio evaluation for admission; please see the GSU catalog for additional information.**
