

## **Transfer Guide for Associate in Applied Science Business and Applied Science**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business and Applied Science degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree from one of the CCC and a Bachelors of Science (BA) degree in Business and Applied Science from GSU.
