The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Illinois Valley Community College (IVCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies program (formerly the Board of Governors Bachelor of Arts degree program) based on the 2008-09 catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree from IVCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) in Interdisciplinary Studies degree from GSU.
