

TRANSFER GUIDE FOR ASSOCIATE OF ARTS ACCOUNTING, 2009-2010

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Accounting degree program based on the 2009-10 catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from JJC and a Bachelors of Science (BS) degree in Accounting from GSU.
