

## **Transfer Guide for Associate of Arts Communication Disorders, 2009-2010**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Communication Disorders degree program based on the 2009 - 10 catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from JJC and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) degree in Communication Disorders from GSU. **In addition to meeting the GSU admission criteria, students must have a grade point average of at least 2.75 for the last 60 hours of undergraduate course work attempted.**
