

**Transfer Guide for Associate of Applied Science in Automotive Technology,  
Business and Applied Science Program 2010-2011**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business and Applied Science (formerly the Business and Technology) degree program based on the 2010-11 catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Automotive Technology degree from KCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business and Applied Science from GSU.
