



**Transfer Guide for Associate of Applied Science in Air Conditioning and Refrigeration

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business and Applied Science (formerly the Business and Technology) degree program based on the 2010-11 catalogs of both schools.
