

**Transfer Guide for Associate in Applied Science in Computer-Aided Drafting

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business and Applied Science (formerly the Business and Technology) degree program based on the 2010-11 catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Computer-Aided Drafting degree from KCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business and Applied Science from GSU.
