

**Transfer Guide for Associate in Applied Science in Construction Management
Business and Applied Science Program**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business and Applied Science (formerly the Business and Technology) degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Construction Management degree from KCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business and Applied Science from GSU.
