

## **Transfer Guide for Associate of Arts Art**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Art degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from KCC and a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) degree in Art from GSU.
