## Transfer Guide for Associate in Arts Communication Disorders, 2010-2011

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Morton College (MC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Communication Disorders degree program based on the 2010-11 catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from MC and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) degree in Communication Disorders from GSU. **In addition to meeting the GSU admission criteria, students must have a grade point average of at least 2.75 for the last 60 hours of undergraduate course work attempted.**
