

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Mathematics degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from JJC and a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree in Mathematics from GSU.
