**Application for Candidacy**

Fall Trimester	September 30
Winter Trimester	January 31

**Requirements**

1. Have completed all undergraduate prerequisites for courses on the study plan.
2. Have completed all course work applicable to the degree with a GPA of 3.0 or higher, with a grade of “B” or better in SPED619 and SPED820 and with a grade of “C” or better in all other courses.
3. Display, or be judged as developing, the dispositions expected of graduate students as listed in the section Teacher Education and Certification in the university catalog.
4. Be recommended for candidacy by the M.A. in Multicategorical Special Education program faculty.

Students not admitted to candidacy will not be permitted to register in courses in the program until they have met the candidacy requirements of the program.
