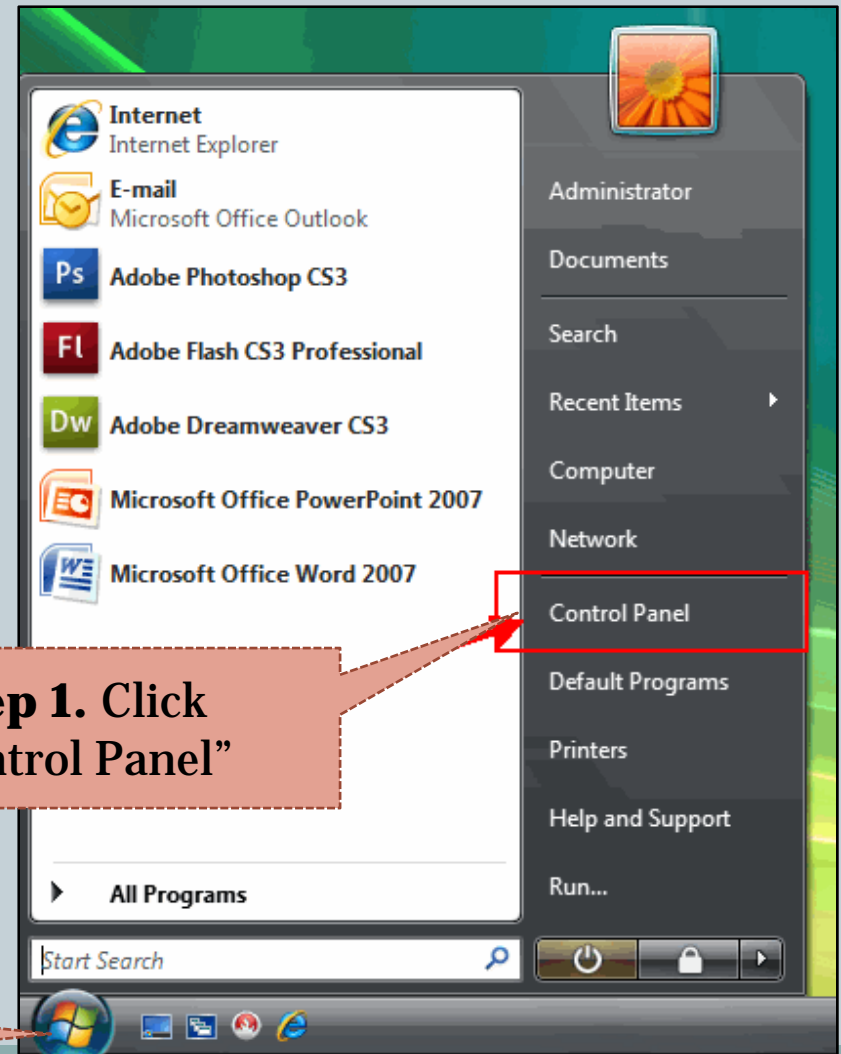

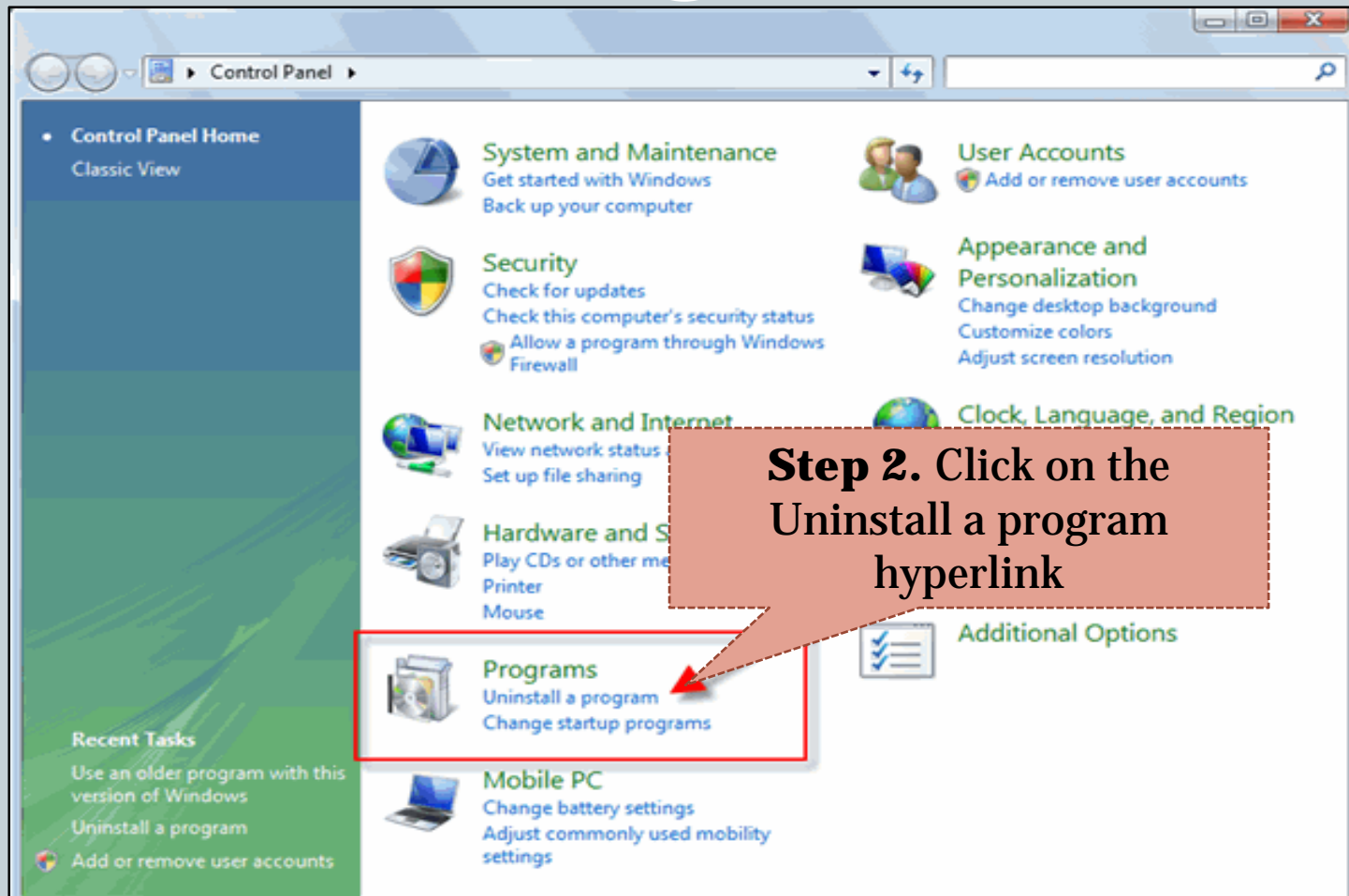
Click the Vista start button to open the programs menu and locate Control Panel
