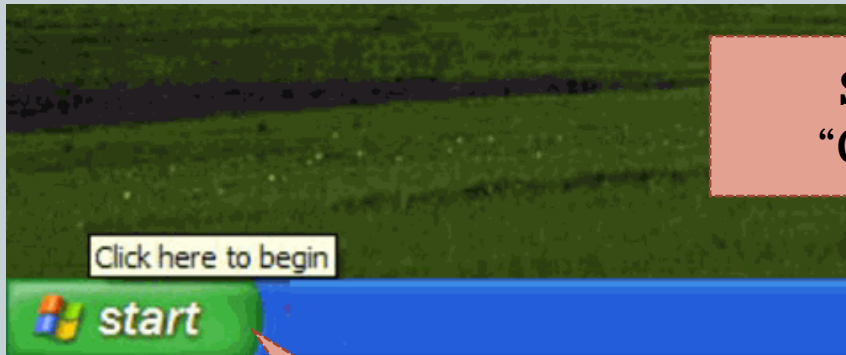


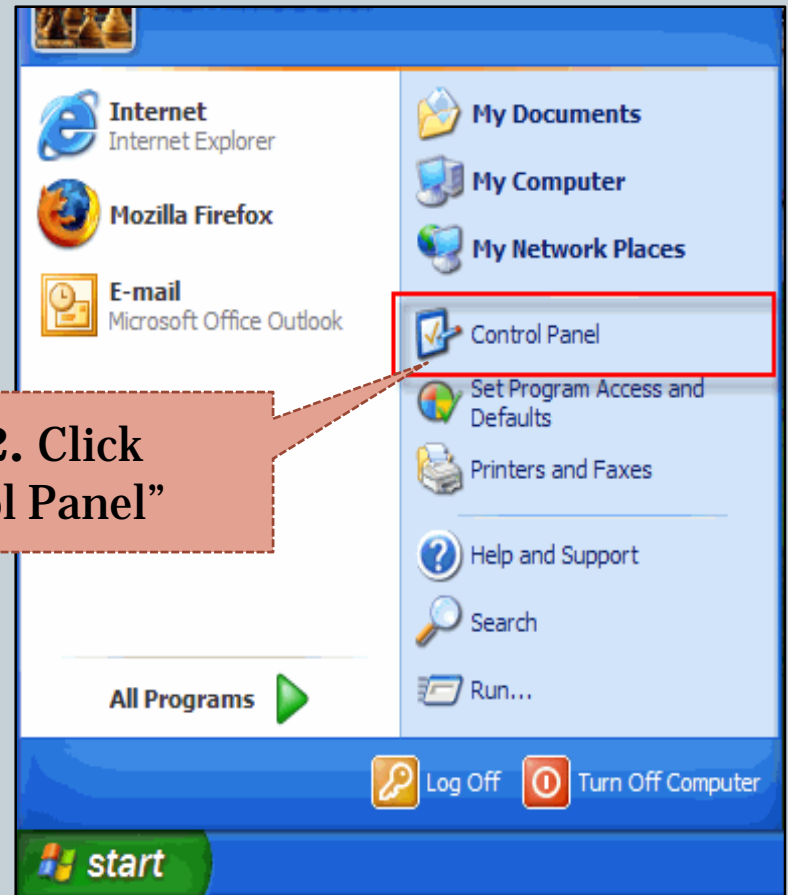
Remove Java: Windows XP

Click the Windows XP Start button to open the programs menu and locate Control Panel

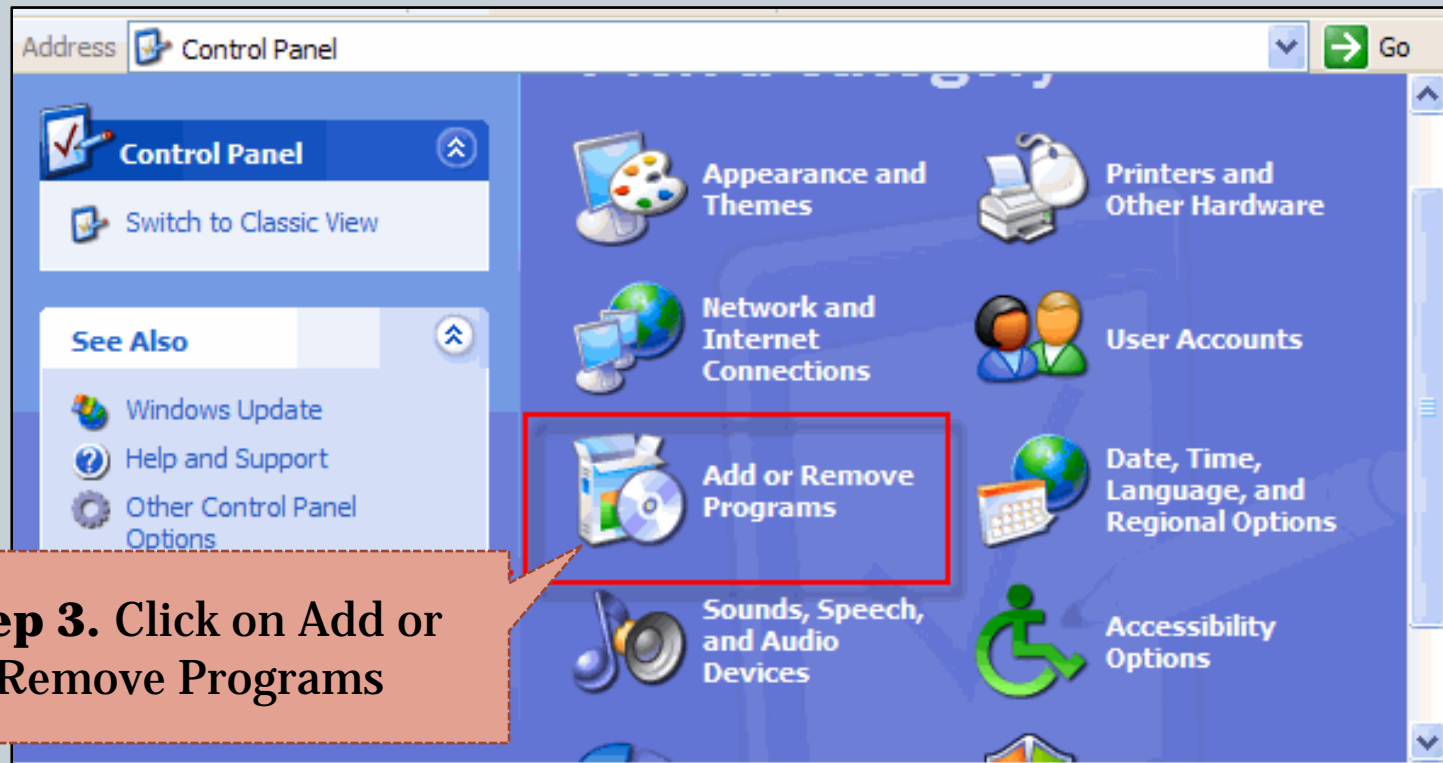


Step 1. XP Start button
