This form must be presented to the Office of Financial Aid once each academic year. The Senior Citizen Tuition Waiver covers tuition and fees for up to six credit hours per trimester. The fees covered are activity fee, student center, counseling and career service and computer technology.

Eligibility

Household size	Annual household income
1	less than \$21,218
2	less than \$28,480
3 or more	less than \$35,740

Students accepted for admission that are 65 years of age or older and meet the above criteria shall be permitted to enroll in regularly scheduled courses, on a credit or noncredit basis, without the payment of tuition and certain fees, provided that available classroom space exists and tuition-paying students enrolled constitute the minimum number required for the course. This regulation shall not apply to courses offered only on a noncredit basis or to courses designed especially for senior citizens.

Accordingly, senior citizens are now required to provide income documentation. A copy of the prior calendar year's 1040 Income Tax Form or Circuit Breaker Tax Relief Claim must be submitted with this application as income documentation.
