

# 2024 SUMMER CAMP AT THE CENTER FAQS

# When is the deadline to register for camp?

Theatre summer camp at the Center has limited spaces and frequently sells out; early registration is recommended. If all spots are not filled in advance, camp registration will close on the following dates:

Annie KIDS/Shrek: June 6, 2024

Teen Intensive: August 1, 2024

### What time should I bring my child to camp?

Camp hours run from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday, except for Wednesday, June 19. Campus will be closed in observance of Juneteenth.

Camp location doors open 15 minutes prior to camp start time. Camp starts at 9:00am; the earliest drop off is 8:45 am. Camp ends promptly at 3:00 p.m. The latest a camper can be picked up is 15 minutes after end of camp at 3:15 p.m. Later pick-ups will be charged a fee.

### What if I signed up for extended day?

If you registered your camper for extended day, the pick-up time is 5pm, Monday - Thursday. A snack will be provided for campers during extended day. Camp teachers will bring campers to the <u>Main Entrance D at 5pm</u>.

### Where is drop-off and pick-up?

Drop-off and pick-up for camp is in the <u>Theater lobby entrance</u> next to the box office of the Center for Performing Arts. Enter through the <u>Main Entrance D</u> and walk straight past the elevators through the Hall of Governors to reach the Theater hallway. Grown-ups must come inside the building to sign in/out the camper with the teachers unless they have given written permission for their child to sign in/out themselves.

### What if we are running late to camp or pick-up?

If you are running late, stuck in traffic, or have any emergencies please call the on-site phone number at 708.235.2237 or 708.235.2238. Before 9:00 a.m., please call 708.534.4046.

In addition, if your camper is going to miss a day of camp, it is helpful to notify us as soon as possible, please call 708.534.4046.

# Who can pick-up my child from camp?

This <u>online registration form</u> is the place to provide names of all individuals approved to pick-up your camper. For your child's safety, no one outside of the approved list will be allowed to pick-up your child. ### What does my child need to bring to camp?

Campers should bring a nut-free lunch and snack Monday through Thursday. Friday a box lunch will be provided for each camper. Please bring your own individual bottle of water daily labeled with your name. A folder/binder, pen, pencil, and highlighter are also helpful, but not required.

# Should my child bring a cell phone to camp?

Cell phones, smart watches, and electronic devices are not needed for camp, and we discourage campers from bringing them. Center phones are available for emergency phone calls. *Campers are responsible for all items they bring to camp.* 

# What should my child wear to camp?

Campers should wear clothes comfortable to move in, <u>closed toe shoes</u> (no sandals or flip-flops), and bring a sweatshirt or jacket. Weather permitting, rehearsals and other activities might be outdoors.

#### Is there an "audition" for roles?

- For *Shrek* Camp, there is no audition. Every camper will determine the best role or them with their camp teachers during normal camp hours.
- For Annie KIDS camp, there is an in-person audition at GovState on Thursday, June 6 from 3-6pm. Campers will be given their Annie KIDS script at the audition and cast list prior to the start of camp. Sign up here for an audition time slot. If your camper cannot attend auditions, they can send us a recorded audition tape. However, in person auditions are preferred.

# When is the final performance?

The final performance for *Shrek* Camp is on Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.

The final performance for *Annie KIDS* Camp is on Friday, June 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.

On these two show days, parents are to pick up their child at 3 p.m. and return them at 6 p.m. to prepare for the show.

### How do I get tickets for the final show?

The camp registration includes two tickets to final performance. Additional tickets are available online or at our box office, for \$10 per ticket. Tickets are available for children who are 14 years old and under for \$5 per ticket. Box Office hours are from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, and from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Thursday.
