

## **Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Gender and Sexuality Studies**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Morton College (MC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Gender and Sexuality Studies degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from MC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Gender and Sexuality Studies from GSU.

### **I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM: (37-38 Hours)**
