

## Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Health Science in Communication Disorders

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Communication Disorders degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) degree in Communication Disorders from GSU. **Students are required to have 2.75 GPA for admission to the GSU Communication Disorders program.**

### I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE (37-39 Hours)

#### Area A: Communications (9 hours)

- ENG 101 - Composition I (3)
- ENG 102 - Composition II (3)
- COMM 101 - Principles of Communication (3)

*\*\*Must have a "C" or better in ENG 101 & 102 to receive credit for the degree.*

#### Area B: Humanities and Fine Arts (9 hours)

- Humanities Course (3)\*
- Fine Arts Course (3)\*
- Humanities or Fine Arts Course (3)\*

#### Area C: Mathematics (3-4 hours)

(Either BUS 240 or MATH 115 or MATH 153 will meet the GSU MATH 2100 requirement.)

- BUS 240 - Elementary Statistics (4) **OR**
- MATH 115 - General Education Statistics (3) **OR**
- MATH 153 - Probability and Statistics (4)

#### Area D: Physical and Life Sciences (7-8 hours)

Select one life science course and one physical science course. One course must have a lab.

- Life Science Course (3-4)\*
- Physical Science Course (3-4)\*

#### Area E: Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 hours)

- PSYCH 101 - Introduction to Psychology (3) (Meets PSYC 1101)
- Social and Behavioral Science Courses (6)\* (at least one non-psychology course)

### II. MAJOR REQUIREMENTS (9 Hours)

- ED 100 - Introduction to Education (3) (Meets EDUC 2310)
- ED 101 - Child Growth & Dev. (3) (Meets PSYC 2201)
- ED 212 - Exceptional Child (3) (Meets SPED 2100)

### III. ELECTIVES (14-16 Hours)

- ECED 201 - Sign Language I (3) (ECED 201 + 202 Meet CDIS 2100)
- ECED 202 - Sign Language II (3) (ECED 201 + 202 Meet CDIS 2100)
- Electives (8-10)
