

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art (Studio Arts Option)

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Art degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from JJC and a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) degree in Art from GSU.
