

Associate of Applied Science in Health Information Management Technology to Bachelor of Health Administration

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Health Administration degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Health Information Management Technology degree from JJC (AHIMA accredited) and a Bachelors of Health Administration (BHA) degree from GSU. **In addition to meeting university criteria, applicant must have obtained a minimum of 2.50 GPA for the last 60 hours.**
