

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Health Science in Community Health

This is an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Community Health degree based upon the current catalogs of both schools. Students would receive an Associate in Arts Degree from PSC and a BHS Degree in Community Health from GSU. **Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for admission to the program.**
