

## Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Health Science in Community Health

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Harper College (Harper) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Community Health degree program based on the current catalogs for both institutions. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from Harper and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) in Community Health degree from GSU. **Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for admission to the program.**
