

## **Associate in Applied Science in Addictions Studies to Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies (Preparing for the Master of Health Sciences in Addictions Studies)**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Addictions Studies degree from CCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) in Interdisciplinary Studies degree from GSU. **This will prepare students for the Addictions Studies graduate program but does not guarantee admission to the program.**
