

## Associate in Applied Science in Architecture to Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Architecture degree from CCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) in Interdisciplinary Studies degree from GSU.
