

Associate of Applied Science in Air Conditioning and Refrigeration to Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Air Conditioning and Refrigeration from KCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from GSU.
