

Associate in Applied Science in Construction Management to Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools.
