

# Associate of Applied Science for WCC Career Programs to Interdisciplinary Studies Program

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Waubonsee Community College (WCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree from WCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) in Interdisciplinary Studies degree from GSU.

Completion of program requirements from programs such as: Accounting, Administrative Office Systems, Auto Body Repair, Automotive Technology, Business Administration, CAD/Drafting, Computer Information Systems, Construction Management, Criminal Justice, Emergency Medical Technician, Entrepreneurship, Fire Science, Graphic Design, Health Care Interpreting, Health Information Technology, Heating Ventilation and AC, Human Services, Interpreter Training, Kinesiology, Legal Interpreting, Machine Tool Technology, Management, Mass Communications, Medical Assistant, Music (Audio Production), Paraprofessional Educator, Patient Care Technician, Phlebotomy Technician, Photography, Real Estate, Surgical Technician, Therapeutic Massage, Welding Technology, World Wide Web.
