Associate of Applied Science in Nursing to Bachelors of Science in Nursing

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Morton College (MC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Nursing degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Nursing from MC and a Bachelors of Science (BSN) degree in Nursing from GSU. **Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for admission to the program. The BSN degree is offered at GSU completely online.**

**30 semester credit hours of lower division Nursing courses will be accepted for transfer towards the BSN; however 38 semester credit hours are required for the AAS in Nursing. No course work will need to be repeated at GSU.

^GSU CHEM 1143/1144 Chemistry II or CHEM 1113/1114 Intro-Organic & Bio Chemistry with Lab can be completed in place of MC CHM 106. If students complete CHEM 100 they will be required to complete CHEM 1113/1114 is an applied nursing focused Organic Chemistry.

NOTE: All transfer course work must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.
