

## **Associate in Arts to Bachelor in Arts in Business Administration**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Waubonsee Community College (WCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business Administration degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from WCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business Administration from GSU.
