# Associate Degree in Nursing to Bachelor of Science in Nursing

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kaskaskia College (KC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Nursing degree program based on the catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate Degree of Nursing (ADN) degree from KC and a Bachelors of Science (BSN) degree in Nursing from GSU. **Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for admission to the program. The BSN degree is offered at GSU completely online.**
