Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Theatre and Performance Studies

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Morton College (MC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Communication degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from MC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Theatre and Performance Studies from GSU.
