

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Theatre and Performance Studies

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Theatre and Performance Studies degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Theatre and Performance Studies from GSU.

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM: (37-38 Hours) (Refer to the AA/AS Degree Guidelines for a list of courses)

Select one life science course and one physical science course. One course must have a lab.

Students should select electives or consider lower division courses towards a minor.

Select one of the following three specializations; see GSU catalog or advisor for course options. At least one course from the specialization must be completed at the 4000 level or higher.

Advanced Selectives (9 hours)

Select three courses at or above the 3000 level in TAPS.

Students are encouraged to select courses towards a minor that complements their degree and career objectives.
