Program Jennifer Barbour	 Sparta Community Hospital has begun implementation of a grant to address health comprehensively. They are one of 10 grantees nationally. Jennifer provided a detailed PowerPoint presentation explaining the various things that contribute to health. Only about 20% of the average person's overall health is impacted by medical services. Things like behavior, housing, transportation, diet and income make up the other 80%. Randolph County health data and demographics were also provided. Randolph County has a very high rate of deaths due to injury as well as a lower average lifespan than the state and nation. Dennis commented that there are many opportunities for SISAA to work with Jennifer. SISAA is now updating its assessment and plans which could support Jennifer's project.
