Welcome Intros Dan Coalition Chair	Introductions made.	NA
Get to know each other Sharon and Dan	<p>Sharon shared that as a parent in the 90s she became concerned about drug misuse which continued in her work as Administrator of the Wash. Co. Health Dept. SISAA is different, it is a coalition that continues to grow and progress. In her experience that is often not the case.</p> <p>Dan wants his 3 young daughters to never experience drug mis-use. Because of drug misuse he sees terrible things that people become involved in as a Drug Court Judge. He joined SISAA to prevent problems like this from happening.</p>	
Prevention Dennis	<p>Re Prevention Week Proclamations, due to COVID challenges Evansville has been delayed and wants to do it next year. We can try for a Recovery proclamation this fall.</p> <p>We are promoting Operation Snowball online trainings to Youth leaders to build on the work we have done.</p> <p>Radio prevention messages have begun at WNSV in Washington Co. and will soon start on WHCO in Randolph Co. Ads target parents and promote talking with their children to set firm no use expectations.</p>	<p>By 6-25 Dennis will:</p> <p>Discuss Recovery Month Proclamations with John Reith.</p> <p>Send another email to youth re online trainings.</p>

	<p>Mariah and Dennis will attend the Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America July conference online. John Reith, Wren, Carol and Dennis are participating in the Coalition Academy on line this summer.</p> <p>We are preparing prevention lesson training for schools in the fall. In particular we are working to involve school counselors as our prevention lessons support communication and goal setting skills that match school counselor efforts.</p> <p>Scott asked about Brent Swolsky's planned March assemblies that were canceled. Dennis shared that plans are in the works to do this in October. Dennis will email school leaders this info.</p>	<p>Check status of radio ads.</p> <p>Email school leaders re scheduling assemblies.</p>
Recovery Dennis in place of John	<p>As John was not feeling well and could not attend Dennis shared that John participated in the Coalition Academy in May. The focus was on drug misuse prevention assessment methods and processes.</p> <p>John is meeting with people exploring how to advance recovery. He is now working to develop an NA group in Chester and is talking with staff of Red Bud Regional Hospital about their plans for an inpatient detox program. The hospital is seeking recovery support services for patients on discharge. He is also planning to meet with Rosette and Tymera Brown later today.</p>	
Engagement and Events Sharon	<p>Has been attending CMWCC meetings. This is a regular meeting of many social service agencies serving Clinton, Marion and Washington Counties. They have an internal Facebook page and are very receptive to sharing our prevention messaging. They update each other on the services they provide and work to coordinate their efforts.</p>	<p>On June 23 Sharon will attend the next meeting.</p>
Wren Strategy and Evaluation Committee	<p>He and Sharon attended training about teens using fake IDs to obtain alcohol. Teens often use family member IDs, college age young people often use fake IDs. Involving Law enforcement and Store owners is needed to address this issue.</p> <p>The Committee drafted proposed goals for the rest of 2020. They are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Program Jennifer Barbour	<p>Sparta Community Hospital has begun implementation of a grant to address health comprehensively. They are one of 10 grantees nationally. Jennifer provided a detailed PowerPoint presentation explaining the various things that contribute to health.</p> <p>Only about 20% of the average person's overall health is impacted by medical services. Things like behavior, housing, transportation, diet and income make up the other 80%.</p> <p>Randolph County health data and demographics were also provided. Randolph County has a very high rate of deaths due to injury as well as a lower average lifespan than the state and nation.</p> <p>Dennis commented that there are many opportunities for SISAA to work with Jennifer. SISAA is now updating its assessment and plans which could support Jennifer's project.</p>	By 6-24 Dennis will communicate with Jennifer about how SISAA can work with her project.
