

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology & Sociology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Joliet Junior College (JJC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Anthropology and Sociology degree program based on the catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from JJC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Anthropology and Sociology from GSU.

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM: (38-39 Hours)

Communications (9 hours)

- ENG 101 - English I (3)
- ENG 102 - English II (3)
- SPCH 101 - Principles of Speech (3)

Humanities and Fine Arts (9 hours)

Mathematics (4 hours)

- MATH 128 - Elementary Statistics (4) (Meets MATH 2100)

Physical and Life Sciences (7-8 hours)

Select one life science course and one physical science course. Once course must have a lab.

Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 hours)

- ANTH 275 - Cultural Anthropology (3) (Meets ANTH 1100)
- SOC 101 - Sociology or Sociology (3) (Meets SOC 1100)
- SOC 220 - Sex, Gender and Power (3) (recommended; meet ANSO 2100 as GSU Selective)

II. ELECTIVES (25-26 Hours)

GSU's Anthropology-Sociology program suggests classes in any of the Social Sciences.

- SOC 290 - Cultural Diversity in America (3) (recommended)
- Free Electives (22-24)*

Selectives (18-21 Hours)

Students should select a minimum of 18 hours of upper-division courses from the approved list of selectives. A lower-division ANSO/ANTH/SOC course can count as a selective with advisor and program coordinator approval. Please meet with your program advisor for anticipated course offerings.

Electives (20-23 Hours)

Additional courses as approved by academic advisor to meet individual outcomes.
